Hello Everyone,

I am emailing you to let you know of an incident that has taken place. Yesterday I got a deposit ready to take to the bank with a total of \$6,670 (\$902 was cash). I was not able to leave the program until after 6:00 and missed going to the bank and planned to do so this morning. When this has happened in the past, I take the bag in my house so it is not in my car. Last night I forgot because I left the deposit bag in my car which was inside another bag. Mine and my husbands vehicles were both broken into last night and the deposit bag was stolen. I did call the police this morning and they did a report. They dusted my car for finger prints to use in their system. The police officer said that whoever stole the bag most likely just took the cash and threw out the rest somewhere.

Janelle and I walked my neighborhood and near by parks, gutters and small stream areas to see if we could find anything, but we did not. I called my home insurance and Willard's insurance. My insurance said that since it was not my property that was taken, they cannot cover anything. Willard's insurance said that since it happened off Willard's property, it would not cover anything and since our deductible is \$1,000 and the cash was less, it wouldn't help anyways.

Janelle and I then called all the parents who had written checks and told them the situation and that they would either need to do a stop payment on the check or to watch their account to see if the check goes through. If the check goes through, I can give them the police report number and they can file a claim at their banks.

Janelle contacted Emily to see what the stop payment fee was at West Gate, which is \$5. I contacted my bank (there was a deposit for staff t-shirts and I had a check to Willard in there) my bank was \$35 and Janelle's was \$34 to stop payment on a check. So when we called parents if they were really upset about the fee we told them that we would deduct it from their child's account.

I can't even put into words how sorry I am that this happened. I would be more than happy to pay Willard the \$902 that is missing from cash and the stop payment fee amount that we will not get back. I feel absolutely horrible that I let this happen. Emily did let me know that I can do the overnight deposit if I don't get to the bank in time which is what I will do from now on. Please let me know if you have any questions.

Thanks for keeping us updated.

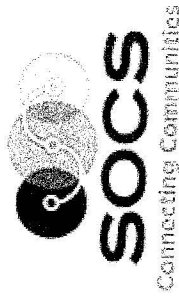

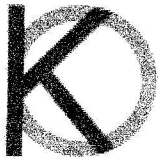
