## About Willard Community Center:

Willard Community Center is a vibrant hub of activities serving the West “A” neighborhood of Lincoln. Originally built as a school house in 1918, Willard was converted to a community center in 1980, and purchased from the City of Lincoln in 2013. Today Willard has evolved into a valued neighborhood asset for everyone in its diverse, multigenerational community – a place where families, teens and seniors feel welcome, comfortable and encouraged to grow.



Willard Community Center is dedicated to nurturing children and strengthening families. Their programs, supportive services, and positive role models help residents grow, connect and contribute to the Willard community and the Lincoln community at large. Relationships formed at the Center last a lifetime, helping to make the area a better place to live, raise a family and enjoy life’s journey.

Willard operates programs in its building as well as two Lincoln Public Schools and an additional LPS owned building; Roper Elementary School, Lakeview Elementary School and the Pre-Kindergarten House at 1030 West “Q” St. In these buildings they offer licensed before and after school programs and preschool for 4-5 year olds at the house. At the Willard facility they offer a licensed before and after school program for Park Middle School students and provide transportation to and from school along with an additional preschool program for 3-4 year olds.

Willard is a 501(c)3 organization located at 1245 S Folsom Street, Lincoln, NE 68522. Willard serves over 1,000 people a month, including building rentals for church groups, family gatherings, scout groups, senior citizens, health group activities and bingo. Willard provides over 315 children ages 3-13 with licensed care, 35% of which received free or reduced lunches at school, and 14% of which receive Title 20 assistance. A large portion of the funding for these programs comes from donations and fundraising such as this.
